Lesson Four - Quick View

	ACTIVITY	TIME	OBJECTIVE	ACTION
1	Greetings	2 min	Set the tone for your class	<i>Champions! Roll Call.</i>
2	Review	3 min	Review <i>When You're a Pirate</i>	Slowly address any tricky spots from last week without the music. Repeat 2-3 times then sing and dance without music. Add music.
3	Sing & Swing	4 min	<i>Guake'te Naniki Guali (We Will Stand)</i>	Listen to song while keeping a steady beat. Learn chorus lyrics by call and response. Learn movements.
4	Video: Lesson #4	5 min	Love Grows	Discuss how a happy, healthy school culture grows when acts of love and honor are shared. Watch video.
5	Opt. Activity	3 min	Pirate Code	Create a classroom or school code of conduct based on honor?
6	Sing & Swing	5 min	<i>We Will Stand</i>	Very slow. Fix any mistakes. Then faster until at tempo. Add music.
7	Video: Episode #4	4 min	The Way of Love	Champions! Adventure Theater
8	Champ Chat	3 min	Review & Reinforce	All Songs. Review lesson.
9	Leadership Challenge	1 min	Honor Goals Bonus: Family Code	Leaders honor others through words and actions. Choose one honor goal for parents, siblings, and friends.

Lesson #4 Details

1. Greetings

Champions! Roll Call

2. Review

15 Men on a Dead Man's Chest and *When You're a Pirate*. Practice perfection.



3. Sing & Swing

We Will Stand

- Listen to *We Will Stand*, while keeping a steady beat.
- Teach the chorus lyrics by call and response.
- Listen again, and have students sing along with the chorus.



- Add movements with the chorus lyrics, then add music.



4. Video Lesson #4

Love Grows

Discuss how to grow love and honor to form the base of your school or family culture.

5. Optional Activity

Honor Code (Family Code)

Discuss the Pirate Code then create a classroom or school Code of Honor.



6. Sing & Swing

We Will Stand

- Practice and review lyrics and movements very slow at first, to fix any mistakes, then speed up to full speed. Don't add music until you've run through it at least two times--then add music.

- Learn verse lyrics.
- Add music. Sing along with all lyrics and do movements for chorus.
- Learn movements for verse.
- When the music starts, count to two before starting the first movement (this is how students know when to start).
- Finish all movements for verse, add music.

7. Video: Episode #4

Guake'te Naniki Guali - The Way of Love.

Pete and the castaways join Chief Bo Guama and the islanders for their Festival of Sonship (generic term for both sons and daughters) and celebration of the way of love.

8. Champ Chat Review

- Review any/all of the songs.
- Review STEM video, Love Grows.
- Make a big deal about the next part of the story! KEEP IT A SECRET AND BUILD SUSPENSE!
